



WONDERWORLD ENTERTAINMENT

TECH RIDER

This information packet has been assembled to give the Presenter and Technical Director the guidelines for presenting WonderWorld in the best possible way. It is understood that many performance spaces may not have the precise equipment and/or resources listed. With prompt and proper notification WonderWorld can modify the specifications listed below.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

The touring technical staff of WonderWorld consists of a Creative Director and a Production Manager. We carry our own costumes, props and sets.

The client shall provide lighting equipment, crew, adequate stage surface for performance, sound system and dressing room(s) described below.

The client shall also provide a tech package detailing the venue, stage, stage equipment to WonderWorld no later than 4 weeks in advance of the engagement. The client must designate a Technical Director with decision-making authority to be present, responsible to and accessible for consultation with WonderWorld at all times during the set-up, rehearsals, performance and strike.

LOAD IN

1. Our equipment travels in snowboard bags and suitcases as baggage check on all airlines. It requires one cargo van, standard or mini van depending on the number of performers for the event date.

PROGRAM

Below is an example of a performance day.

1. Typical tech schedule:

8:00am - **Load in/Set up**

11:30am - **Lunch Break**

12:00pm - **Tech Rehearsal / Lighting and Sound Check**

4:30pm - **Dinner Break**

5:30pm - **Make-up/Costume**

7pm - **Doors Open**

7:20pm - **Artists Standby**

7:30pm – **Show Time**

2. Venue shall not be used by any other attraction, event, etc once WonderWorld has begun to load-in and until after the final performance's load out.

SOUND

This is a General sound package that can be modified.

1. Speakers: A) High quality stereo system capable of providing full bandwidth reproduction to all seats without distortion. B) Good quality sub bass able to reproduce all low frequencies without damaging house system.
2. (2) On-stage monitor speakers located Stage Left and Stage Right. (Optional)
3. Sound mixing position must be in a location as to be able to judge the quality and volume of the sound. (In house is best) (Optional)
4. CD players.
5. All of WonderWorld's sound is pre-recorded on CD-R format.
6. (1) Wireless lavalier style body microphone and (1) hand held wireless microphone.
7. Headsets for production staff ; 1-Backstage, 1-Production Supervisor, 1-Lighting Director, 2-Follow spot operators and 1-Sound.
8. If using headsets then they must be live and placed 1 hour before rehearsal.

STAGE

This is a General Stage package that can be modified.

1. Performance area shall have a minimum dimension of 25'Q xW25'D. 19' H.
2. Surface should be Marley or Wood; black or dark color is preferred.
3. Floor must be smooth, level, clean, free of pits, gaps, splinters, tape or protrusions of any kind. A level floor is critical for MONTAGE. If the floor conditions are unsuitable for the act, then it may be modified or cut at the discretion of WonderWorld's Creative Director.
4. Floor must not be heavily waxed.
5. Stage shall be swept and moped, Bucket and mop to remain available at all times.

L I G H T I N G

All lighting instruments are to be supplied in proper working condition with the correct globes, barn doors, shutters, and safety chains fitted. All lighting instruments to be supplied with gel frames, gel Color Red, Blue, Magenta, Amber and Green

WonderWorld will provide 6 gobos that will be used with source 4's

WonderWorld will attempt to modify the lighting plot in accordance with the equipment that the venue readily has available.

M I S C E L L A N E O U S

Minimum temperature of 68 degrees F and a maximum of 75 F shall be maintained in performance areas, the rehearsal space and dressing rooms during WonderWorld's use.

House staff will clear with WonderWorld production supervisor before the house is open.

Adequate backstage security to insure the safety, privacy and property of the performers.

All of WonderWorld's equipment shall stay assembled and safely stored, when not in use, in a locked, dry and secure area of the theatre.

All visitors shall be excluded from the venue during set-up and rehearsal periods unless permission is mutually agreed between client and WonderWorld.

Parking spaces for all WonderWorld vehicles shall be provided as near the performing area as possible.

No photography or recording devices at any time during rehearsals or performances unless authorized by the managing director for WonderWorld.

H O S P I T A L I T Y

Adequate fresh bottled drinking water for 10 people shall be made available off-stage and/or in the dressing rooms at all times from load in to strike.

(2) 8' banquet tables, face towel, chairs, 2 waste baskets, 2 standing or table mirrors, (2) clothing racks, with 25 hangers located in the dressing room.

2 hours before any performance, hospitality set up should be provided as follows:

Beverage Station to include: Bottled Water, Asst. Fruit Juices, Hot Coffee & Tea with appropriate condiments; cups, glasses & ice

LUNCH

The following set up for self-serve sandwich making for two sandwiches, PER PERSON to include:

Choose (2) Items from the Following Deli Meat Options: Fresh Sliced Turkey Breast or Sliced Ham
Choose (2) Items from the Following Salad Options: Tuna Salad or Chicken Salad (Light mayo in all salads)
Garden Salad with choice of 2 dressings (Vinaigrette style and Creamy style)
Assorted Sliced Cheeses (American, Muenster & Swiss)
Assorted Breads (White, Whole Wheat & Rye)
Sliced Tomatoes and Lettuce, Mayonnaise, Mustard & Ketchup
Potato Chips, Cookies, Fruit Salad or Fruit Platter

DINNER

The following set up for self-serve, PER PERSON to include:

Mixed Garden Salad with choice of 2 dressings (Vinaigrette style & Creamy style)
Assorted Cheese Tray (Muenster, Cheddar and Swiss)
Assorted Dinner Rolls with butter
Choose (1) Item From the Entrée Options: Broiled or Grilled Chicken, Beef OR Turkey
Choose (1) Item From the Starch Options: Hot Pasta Dish, Wild Rice, Steamed Vegetables
Choose (2) Items From the Following Dessert Options: Cookies, Cake or Assorted Fresh Fruit

- * If requested the Food & Beverage must remain in dressing room through show's conclusion & be replenished immediately following final bow.
- * Food Options subject to change based on rehearsal & show schedule
- * A designated green room shall be made available for WonderWorld staff at all Tech rehearsals and performances.
- * Preferred that meals are rotated so that same meal is not served everyday
