The Texas Commission on the Arts (TCA) is pleased to announce that Dallas String Quartet has been accepted onto the 2018-2020 Texas Touring Roster. The Texas Touring Arts Program is designed to ensure that all Texans have the ability to enjoy performances and presentations in their own communities by outstanding Texas-based companies and artists. TCA provides grants to help with the costs of bringing in companies and artists from this roster for performances.

The appointment to the roster will be in effect September 1, 2018–August 31, 2020. Roster placement does not guarantee bookings and there are no funds reserved in your name. Presenters interested in booking you will contact you directly to arrange booking dates, to negotiate fees, and to enter into a formal contractual agreement. Eligible presenters may apply for a percentage of the negotiated fee on an Arts Respond Performance Support grant application form. Attached is information for you about the roster and information to share with potential presenters.


We ask that all roster artists take part in a TCA webinar to help you conduct your business better. Information on the webinar will be e-mailed to you shortly. Please make note of the quarterly deadlines for Arts Respond Performance Support grant applications. This means that you may need to confirm your bookings earlier than in the past to allow your presenter time to submit an application to TCA.
